To be held in the hall at Starbeck Methodist Church
Saturday 19 August 2017 11:30am – 3:00pm

Rules

1. All exhibits in horticultural classes must be grown by the exhibitor in their own garden, allotment or greenhouse.
2. Organisers will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit.
3. Entry fee is 25p per entry.
4. The decision of the judges is final.
5. Entry forms must be sent or taken to Mitchell's Butchers High Street, Starbeck or Starbeck Library before Wednesday 16 August 2017 by 5:00 pm.
6. All exhibits must be staged between 8:30 am and 10:00 am on the day of the show.
7. Exhibits must not be removed before 2:30 pm on the day of the show but must be removed before 3:00 pm. If you wish to leave your produce for sale please collect a red sticker. All proceeds will go to Starbeck in Bloom.
8. Judging will commence at 10:00 am. All exhibitors must vacate the show room during judging.
9. Prize money and trophies will be allocated after 2:45 pm. All cups are perpetual and cannot be won outright - held for one year only.

FRUIT & VEGETABLE SECTION

- 1 Four tomatoes on a plate (not cherry)
- 2 Six Cherry tomatoes on a plate
- 3 Three onions grown from seed, tied
- 4 Three onions from sets, under 1lb each tops to be tied
- 5 Four potatoes – to be labelled for variety
- 6 Four runner beans
- 7 Four French Beans
- 8 Two leeks, trimmed= up to 12 inches green tops
- 9 Two courgettes no more than 8 inches
- 10 Four beetroot, trimmed with 4 inches stalks
- 11 One cauliflower, trimmed
- 12 One saucer of soft fruits – one variety no more than 20
- 13 Three apples – dessert or cooking. Variety to be named
- 14 1 of any vegetable not named in above classes

FLOWER SECTION (Vases to be provided by exhibitor)

- 15 Vase of five carnations, mixed or single colours
- 16 Vase of garden flowers, annuals or perennials.
- 17 Vase of three dahlias
- 18 Vase of six sweet peas
- 19 Vase of three gladioli
- 20 Vase of two roses - to be judged for perfume only
- 21 Six pansy heads on velvet covered board
- 22 One Fuchsia, any variety, 5" to 14" pot
- 23 One geranium, any variety, 5" to 14" pot
- 24 Any other flowering pot plant, 5" to 14" pot
- 25 Bud vase arranged with fresh cut flowers

PRODUCE

- 26 4 Blueberry Muffins
- 27 Loaf of bread made from packet bread mix made by hand or machine
- 28 4 pieces Fruit Flapjack, any dried fruit may be used.
- 29 One Victoria jam sponge cake – raspberry jam, caster sugar and no cream
- 30 One saucer apple pie
- 31 One Lemon Drizzle loaf Cake
- 32 6 pieces Fudge
- 33 One jar of jam, strawberry
- 34 One jar of chutney, rhubarb

HANDCRAFT

- 35 One knitted novelty tea cosy or hat
- 36 A piece of embroidery– framed
- 37 A patchwork item max 1 metre square

- 38 Soft toy suitable for baby –any material
- 39 Handcrafted card 'Congratulations' judged for front only
- 40 Gift wrapped parcel judged for appearance
- 41 Painting – any medium size Max 30 cm [12inches]
- 42 Painting any medium size over 30 cm [12 inches]
- 43 A photograph title 'Starbeck is Special'
[A new trophy in memory of Elliott Clark will be awarded for this class]

CHILDRENS CLASSES – up to 15 years (please state age on entry form)

- 44 A decorated bookmark—can be pre entered or made on the day
- 45 A beaded bracelet can be pre-entered or made on day
